TOKI

Why should people go there?

What's a must have?

When is the best time to go?


What's a must have?

Why should people go there?


This haven for prop stylists next to the Noordermarkt and cafe Winkel is a great place to buy or find inspiration with a rustic or antique style.

Why should people go there?


It's one of the best eateries on Prinsengracht!

When is the best time to go?































BURGERMEESTER
